Frankfort – Pauline Juett Rarden Marraccini, age 98, went home to be with her Lord on Friday, April 10, 2026. She died peacefully at her home in the company of family. Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Thursday, April 16, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. with Pastor Mike Colston officiating. Burial will follow at Frankfort Cemetery. Visitation will be at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home from 11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. on Thursday.

She has six grandchildren, Christopher Scott, Michael, Steven, and Jacob Marraccini, and Caitlin Moreland and Taylor Richardson; as well as ten great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.

A life-long member of Memorial Baptist Church, she was active in her Sunday

School Class, regularly hosting its members in her home. She was a member of the Church Choir and often a soloist with her beautiful soprano voice.

Gardening and raising beautiful flowers admired by many was also her life-long passion. An avid seamstress, she also created endless garments for her daughters. As she physically slowed in recent years, she frequently wished aloud to “just be able to get out and get her hands in the dirt again.”
