Phillip Booker Jr., age 66, passed away Thursday, March 21, 2013, at Frankfort Regional Medical Center.

Services for Mr. Booker will be 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, March 27, 2013, at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home with Rev. Jamel Armstrong officiating. Burial will follow in Frankfort Cemetery. Visitation will be at the funeral home Wednesday from 11:00 a.m. until the service at 1:00 p.m.

Mr. Booker was born May 30, 1946, in Norfolk, VA. He was a United States Army veteran and retired from Kentucky State University where he was an Associate Professor. Mr. Booker was a former assistant coach for Frankfort High School Panthers football team and was inducted into the Frankfort High School Football Hall of Fame. He was a pillar in the community and touched the lives of people of all ages.

He is survived by his children, Faye Baskin (Roger), Denitra Booker, Philip Booker III; five grandchildren, Ariel Wigginton, Roger Baskin Jr., Nia Baskin, Joshua Baskin, Thandie Baskin; brothers, Calvin Booker, Mac Booker, George Booker (Wanda); sisters, Tronette Barnes, Geneva Pasley, Annie Duggar (Larry), Debra Friday (Joe), Angela Newsome, Camille Sawyer (Troy); and a host of relatives and friends.
