Rebecca died Sunday, November 4, 2007, at the Frankfort Regional Medical Center following an illness.

Born March 15, 1970, she was a native of Franklin County and was a former Administrative Assistant for Kentucky State Government, Cabinet of Human Resources. She was a graduate of Cumberland College and was currently attending the Baptist Seminary of Kentucky College. Rebecca participated in summer mission work for the Kentucky Baptist Convention. She was a member of Hillcrest Baptist Church.
