



## Reuben Eugene Smith

May 31, 1928 - February 23, 2014

Frankfort - Reuben Eugene Smith, 85, of Lawrenceburg passed away at his home on Sunday, February 23, 2014, after a long illness. He was a member of Sand Spring Baptist Church in Lawrenceburg and former member of Swallowfield Baptist Church in Frankfort.
