Robert Parker Comley, 92 years, passed away Friday, November 8, 2013, at home.

Bob was born in Irvine, Kentucky on July 14, 1921, and was the son of the late Dr. H.J. and Sarah Parker Comley. He was a World War II veteran serving in the United States Navy.
