



## Robert R. Ueltschi

February 11, 1931 - June 12, 2011

Frankfort " Robert R. "Bobby" Ueltschi, 80, of Frankfort, died June 12, 2011, at the Hospice Care Center in Lexington following a short illness.

A native of Frankfort, he was a 1949 graduate of Frankfort High School and studied civil engineering at the University of Kentucky. He was a registered land surveyor and was retired from the Public Service Commission. He served in the Air Force during the Korean War and was a member of VFW Post 4075 and BPOE Elks Lodge 530.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Marguerite Cook Ueltschi, as well as his brother, Ronald F. Ueltschi.
