Frankfort – Howard Russell “Russ” Sparks, age 72, passed away at home on Sunday, February 16, 2020. Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Thursday, February 20, 2020, at 1:00 p.m. with Rev. Todd Lester officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens. 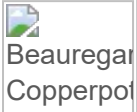
