She died peacefully at her residence on Monday, June 16, 2008.

Born October 17, 1934 in Hopkins County, she was a graduate of Madisonville High School and attended Centre College and the University of Kentucky, where she was a member of Alpha Delta Pi sorority. She was a former Deputy Judge Executive of Pike County and served Gov. Paul Patton as his Chief Executive Officer. She was a member of the Episcopal church.

She is survived by her husband, Ernest Reid Chaney; her children, Daniel Chaney, Sunnyvale, CA, and Anne Chaney, Frankfort; daughter-in-law Rita Coleman Chaney of Shelbiana; and five grandchildren, and great-

grandchildren.
