Scott A. Perry passed away on Tuesday, August 2, 2022, surrounded by his family. Services will be held at Forks of Elkhorn Baptist Church at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 9, 2022. with Rev. Scott loved Country and Gospel music and was the lead singer and guitarist with bands such as The Red Bus Stop, the Kentucky Rebels, and the New Country Band. You may have heard him sing locally throughout the years at Country Place Jamboree, Six Mile Jamboree, Lincoln Jamboree, and Renfro Valley. During his music career, he fronted several music stars including Loretta Lynn, Hank Williams Jr., Tanya Tucker, and George Jones among others, and was a regular at Ernest Tubbs Midnight Jamboree in Nashville and recognized by Dottie Rambo for including her gospel songs in his shows.

As Scott's family grew, he loved spending time with them going to dirt track

racing, camping, and boating on the lake. He also fell in love with restoring classic cars. Scott was featured in several magazines and won on local and national levels. He met many lifelong friends along the way. Anyone who met Scott loved his personality and enjoyed a good joke now and then. His love for his family and friends and just enjoying life while making memories will last a lifetime.

Scott is survived by his wife of 46 years, Jeanie (Regina) Perry, his son, Brian Perry (Alexa) daughter, Autumn Brewer (Brian), and grandchildren, Zachary Perry, Abby Brewer, Camden Perry, Macie Perry, Bella Perry, and Sadie Brewer.
