Frankfort – Sterling “Foxye” Tracey, age 94, passed away on Thursday, September 8, 2022. Funeral services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Thursday, September 15, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. with Rev. Gene Wright officiating. Burial will follow at Frankfort Cemetery.
