Frankfort – Cecil “Tommy” Duvall, born in Frankfort, Kentucky on January 15, 1931, to Mary Geraldine Gaines Duvall and Orville Ransford Duvall, Sr., passed away at his home on June 1, 2024. Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Thursday, June 6, 2024, at 10:30 a.m. Rev. Clint Walker and Pastor Larry Sowders officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens. 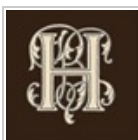
