Virginia Louise Harrod Watkins, age 90, passed away Sunday, November 4, 2012, at Frankfort Regional Medical Center.

Services for Mrs. Watkins will be 10:30 a.m. Thursday, November 8, 2012, at Crestwood Baptist Church with Dr. Michael Hail officiating. Burial will follow in Lebanon Baptist Church Cemetery. Visitation will be at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Wednesday.

A lifelong resident of Franklin County, she was born January 25, 1922, the second of five children and first daughter of Chauncy and Ora Elizabeth Brophy Harrod. She was a graduate of Bald Knob High School, Class of 1939 and worked briefly at the Union Underwear factory before enrolling in the Shaw Secretarial School in Frankfort in 1940. At the age of 30, she went to work for Commonwealth of Kentucky, retired after 30 years of service and enjoyed 30 years of retirement. Mrs. Watkins was an Avon consultant for 45 years.
