Frankfort - William Martin Bill Wilhoite, age 72, passed away Tuesday, December 23, 2014, at Frankfort Regional Medical Center.

Services for Bill will be 11:00 a.m. Monday, December 29, 2014, at North Frankfort Baptist Church. Rev. David Smith assisted by Rev. Todd Lester will officiate. Burial will follow in Peaks Mill Cemetery. Visitation will be at church Sunday evening from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and prior to the service on Monday from 9:00 a.m. until the service hour.

A Frankfort native, Bill was born August 4, 1942, the son of the late Ira Martin and Arvie Mae Poe Wilhoite. He served in the Kentucky National Guard. Bill retired as Division Director, Division of Drivers Licensing, Transportation Cabinet, Kentucky State Government. Upon leaving state government, Bill became the first Executive Director for Trust for Life. Bill enjoyed farming and was an avid UK fan following both the basketball and football programs. He was a member of North Frankfort Baptist Church.

Bill and his wife, the former Lisa Gaye Flynn, celebrated 40 years of marriage December 20, 2014. Also left to cherish his memory is their son, Jeffrey Wilhoite and his wife April; his sisters, Marie Collins (Ken), Jessie Luscher (Doug); sister-in-law, Patsy Wilhoite; and numerous nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by brothers, Elzie Ray and
