William Porter Douthitt, age 92, passed away Friday, January 1, 2016.

Graveside services for Porter will be 2:30 p.m. Wednesday at Monterey Cemetery with Rev. David Smith officiating. Visitation will be at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home Wednesday from noon until 2:00 p.m.

Porter was born January 14, 1923, in Orville (Henry County), KY. He served in the United States Army during World War II. Porter retired as the owner and operator of Ky Automotive and soon after began 18 years of employment with the City of Frankfort as a courier. Porter was a 40 year member of Hiram Lodge #4 F&AM and as a long-time Lions Club member, he was dedicated to their service project of collecting old eye glasses and frames, many of which were used by doctors involved in missionary work.
