William John "Jack" Ingram, 96, widower of Winifred Nancy Ingram died Tuesday, December 23, 2008, at the Frankfort Regional Medical Center and was cremated. He was born in Dorset, England to the late William Harry & Edith Emily Ingram. He served seven years in the British Royal Navy during WWII. After his discharge, he worked in the Automobile Industry in Oxford, England. After his retirement, he and his wife moved to the United States in 1981 to be with their only child, Myfanwy Monica Ingram Eads and her husband Lorenzo Dow Eads. Other surviving relatives are five grandchildren Carolyn S. Eads, Columbia, SC, Lorenzo D. Eads Jr. (Belinda), Gilmer, Texas, Robert A. Eads, Diana E. Eads and Laura J.
