He died peacefully Wednesday, May 14, 2008 at his residence following a sudden illness.

Born December 6, 1962 in Franklin County, he was a former Supervisor for Kentucky State Government. He was a sound man in the Lexington music scene in the late '80's and early '90's. He was also an actor with the Pegasus Players.
